Rules and Regulations

The following RULES and REGULATIONS are for the protection of all club members. These rules have been established to assure safe and sanitary operation of the Club facilities. Parents are responsible for the conduct of their children and guests and are requested to caution their children and guests to observe all rules and obey instructions of the pool management. Violations of these rules will be considered sufficient cause to subject offenders to disciplinary action by the pool management.

A. CLUB HOURS

1. 11:00 A.M. to 9:00 P.M. Weekdays, Saturdays and Holidays, except on school days or posted special events. 1:00 P.M. to 9:00 P.M. on Sundays. The pool will be closed fifteen minutes prior to the Club closing.
2. The Club reserves the right to close an area of the pool for approved group or individual instruction, Monday to Friday.

B. MEMBER OBLIGATIONS

1. Members must present membership cards at the window upon entering the Club, and pick up membership cards when leaving the Club.
2. No member will be admitted without a membership card.
3. Membership cards are non-transferable.
4. If membership cards are lost or stolen, members must purchase replacement card(s).
5. MEMBERS ARE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR THE SAFETY AND CONDUCT OF THEIR CHILDREN, GUESTS AND BABYSITTERS THROUGHOUT ALL CLUB BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS.
6. Food and refreshments are to be consumed ONLY on the patio, the social hall or the picnic area. ABSOLUTELY NO FOOD OR REFRESHMENTS ARE ALLOWED ON THE POOL DECK AREA.
7. All bicycle riders must park their bicycles in the designated areas.
8. Baby carriages are not permitted on the paved areas of the main pool.
9. No intoxicants may be brought onto the Club premises.
10. Members should not conduct unnecessary conversations with lifeguards who are on duty.
11. Members are not permitted in the office area unless called to enter by the pool STAFF.
12. All incoming and outgoing telephone calls should be made through the Club's pay telephone, 829-9718.

C. BABYSITTERS

1. Babysitters are not members of the Club and may not bring guests.
2. Babysitters may use the Club facilities only when babysitting.
3. Babysitters must present color coded card when entering the Club.
4. Babysitters must be at least 14 years of age.

D. RESIDENT SUMMER GUESTS

1. Resident summer guests must reside at the member's residence the majority of the summer swimming season (June through August).
2. Resident summer guests are not members and may not bring guests.

E. DAY GUESTS

1. Each member family is entitled to 20 guest privileges per season.
2. A guest Privilege consists of the admission of one individual to the Club for one day.
3. Members and their guests must be 11 years old or older to enter the Club without an adult.
4. Conduct of guests is the direct responsibility of the sponsoring member. This includes both adult and children guests using the pool.
5. Guest fees are collected in cash or check upon registration and are not refundable.
6. Current Guest fees: (1) Weekdays \$5.00 per person; (2) Weekends and Holidays \$5.00 per person, and (3) Senior Citizens half price with proof of age. (65 or older)

F. HEALTH and SAFETY

1. **ANY CHILD NOT COMPLETELY TOILET TRAINED IS NOT PERMITTED IN THE MAIN POOL UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCE. VIOLATIONS ARE GROUNDS FOR SUSPENSION FROM THE CLUB.**
2. Sand, grass and gravel must be washed from feet prior to entering the pool.
3. Admission to the pool will be refused to anyone with colds, coughs, inflamed eyes, suspected infections and/or contagious diseases, or wearing bandages.
4. Pets are not allowed on Club property at any time.
5. NO GLASS CONTAINERS of any kind are permitted anywhere on the Club premises.
6. Running, pushing, wrestling or causing undue disturbances in or about the pool area are prohibited.
7. Excessive splashing is prohibited.
8. No inflatable or buoyant tubes, floats, bubbles, toys or other paraphernalia (except masks, snorkel tubes and flippers) are allowed in the main pool.
9. No objects of any kind are to be thrown into the pool.
10. Appropriate swim wear is required.
11. Swimmers are not permitted to use the non-swimming area (three foot deep section) of the main pool unless supervising a non-swimmer.

G. DIVING

1. Persons deemed unsafe by lifeguards and/or manager may not use the diving well area. Only one person at a time is permitted on the diving board.
2. Each diver must wait until the previous diver has cleared the diving area by swimming away from the board to the nearest exit ladder.
3. Diving from the pool sides into the diving well area is prohibited, unless permitted by a lifeguard.
4. Diving from the pool sides is permitted only into the main swimming area (five foot section) of the pool.
5. Diving off the starting blocks without coach supervision is prohibited.

H. CHILDREN

1. The use of the wading (baby) pool is limited to infants and non-swimmers. Only soft, non-rigid toys are allowed in the wading pool.
2. Children in the wading pool **MUST** be accompanied by an adult or babysitter of at least 14 years of age.
3. Parents are required to keep non-toilet trained children dressed in suitable, highly protective diaper coverings to prevent contamination of the wading pool.
4. Non-swimmers **MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A PARENT** when in the swimming areas of the main pool.
5. Children who appear cold or fatigued may be requested to take a rest.
6. Children may not loiter in the bathrooms, first aid area, storage areas, social hall or office area.
7. Children over 10 years of age are not permitted to use the wading pool area play facilities.
8. All children under the age of 11 **MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT OR A RESPONSIBLE BABYSITTER** (14 years or older) at all times on Club premises.

I. GENERAL

1. The Club is not responsible for loss of, or damage to personal property.
2. The Club may be closed for maintenance operations, health conditions, inclement weather or other reasons deemed sufficient by the pool management

J. DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURES

1. MINOR VIOLATIONS of Club Rules and Regulations are normally handled by the Club manager and his/her staff.
2. MAJOR VIOLATIONS of Club Rules and Regulations will be reported to and handled by the Board of Governors. Major violations include, but are not limited to, the following: (a) Fraud, (b) Vandalism, (c) Theft, (d) Gross health violation, and (e) Repeated minor violations.
3. Any offender(s) will be automatically suspended from the Club pending Board of Governors committee review.
